Sing a Sign

Deb Fontaine will be coming back to Breezy Knoll on Tuesdays every other week to teach the Preschool and the Pre-k classes Sign Language. The cost for each class is \$5.00. This will start on 10/9.

Sing a Sign is a Sign Language Program for hearing children which is taught through songs, games, rhymes and fun! The children are taught the sign language alphabet, animals, family members, colors, simple sentences, finger spelling, introductions, their names and more.

There are many benefits of a hearing child learning sign language; memory, brain growth and development, stimulates formation of brain synapses, benefits ADD and dyslexic children, early spelling, reading, focus and concentration... and its fun!

Each class the children will take home a paper with the new sign they've learned. They also will review previous signs they've learned during class in addition to our new sign through songs, games, rhyme and fun.
